Jazz Dancing

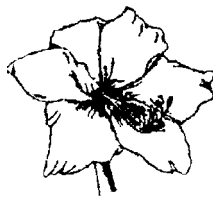

Dear Members,

Recently the Club was in communication with Progress Energy Corporation in regards to the quality of the electric service we have been receiving. It was determined that we have a faulty transformer. The transformer is located in the area of the south parking lot against the outside wall of the kitchen. It is leaking oil and must be replaced. This provides electric service to the main clubhouse, the snack bar, the pools and the administration office. Play on the golf course will not be affected.

Progress energy informed us that it will take six to twelve hours to put



a new transformer in place. It can be done in one day but it will require some very large and noisy equipment. It will also require the Club to close the south parking lot for the entire day.

Please note that this will take place on Monday, July 12th from 8:00 a.m. through about 8:00 p.m. The Club appreciates your understanding as we will close the affected areas for that entire day. Notices will be placed around the Club as a reminder as we approach the service date. See you at the Club and thanks again for your understanding.

From The Greens

The product "Curfew" will be applied on the Challenger course on July 11, and on July 18 to the Champ course. Each of these courses will close at 4:00 p.m. on that particular Sunday so the product can be put out. The Curfew treatment is for the control of nematodes, grubs and mole crickets in the greens.



We had a good overseeing this past winter and the summer transition is now complete. The Bermuda grass is presently growing in nicely. One of the keys to having a good overseeding is to have a strong Bermuda grass base which we are now striving to obtain.

This summer we will be removing trees that Pasco County has designated as "hazardous". We will be obtaining permits for this work. The county is allowing us to remove trees presently hindering SSGCC from having good quality turf on the putting and tee surfaces.

We are also in the process of planting our summer annuals and should be done by the first week of July. The new landscaping of the front of the Palm Room should also be completed by approximately this same time.

From The Pro

Analyze Your Ball Flight

The diagram below represents the Ball Flight Laws in golf. There is no better way to spot swing flaws than to watch the ball fly. As always, everything is relative to the target. The path of the club should travel on a line through the ball, to the target. Any variation from this will cause the ball to start off line. If the ball starts out straight at the target, your club head is moving



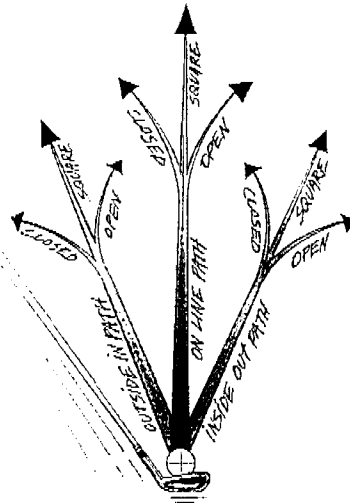
correctly along the target line at impact. If the ball starts out to the right, your swing path is too much from the inside-out. If the ball starts left, your swing path is from the outside-in.

The secondary direction the ball flies is either a slice or a hook, or best of all, it continues to go straight. The secondary direction is created by the face of the club at impact. If the club face is open at impact, your ball will curve from left to right (slice or fade). If the club face is closed at impact, your ball will curve from right to left (draw or hook).

The most common shot in amateur golf is to pull the shot to left, and slice it back to the target. The ball flight laws tell us that this swing was outside-in with an open club face.

You figure this one out: The player's ball started out to right of the target and then hooked back to the flag. What was his swing path, and where was the club face at impact?
